

## ABOUT TIGER'S DEN

The Tiger's Den Food Pantry was founded in May 2017 as an extension of the Amherst School System's Food to Home Program. In its first year of operation, Tiger's Den assisted 24 families in need in zip code 14226. Today we serve more than 82 families. Although housed on St. Paul's Lutheran Church property, Tiger's Den Food Pantry is a community-based partnership with the Amherst Schools and local area churches. Anyone in zip code 14226 who is in need or is referred by another agency is welcome at Tiger's Den Food Pantry.

Tiger's Den is managed and staffed by a dedicated group of volunteers, and is solely supported by the Western New York Food Bank, and donations from individuals, churches, and civic organizations in Western New York.

In addition to non-perishable food products, through the generosity of many donors, Tiger's Den also offers personal care items, paper products, seasonal fresh fruit and vegetables, and fresh bakery products.
